

**RESOLUTION
R 207 - 08/09**

WHEREAS, on April 28, 2009, a majority of electors voted in favor of an elected school board; and

WHEREAS, per Act Number 2008-498, the election of the initial members of the Board of Education shall be elected during a special election called by the Selma City Council as soon as practicable; and

WHEREAS, the Selma City Council desires to hold a special election to allow the qualified electors an opportunity to elect members to the Selma City Board of Education for Districts 1, 2, 3, and 4 and to elect from the city at large, a Chair of the board; and

WHEREAS, the Selma City Council on May 26, 2009, with a unanimous vote, approved October 27, 2009 as the date to hold a special; and

WHEREAS, the Selma City Council further desires that during the special election on October 27, 2009, that it also be submitted to the qualified electors of said city for their determination whether the city of Selma shall be authorized to issue, on its credit, its General Obligation Bonds for acquiring, providing and constructing municipal improvements.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Selma, that the City Attorney is hereby requested to seek preclearance from the United States Justice Department on holding a special election on October 27, 2009 for the following:


- a. To elect the initial members of Selma City Board of Education for Districts 1, 2, 3, and 4 and to elect from the city at large, a chair of the Board; and
- b. To be submitted to the qualified electors of said city for their determination by ballot whether the City of Selma shall be authorized to issue, on its credit, its General Obligation Bonds for acquiring, providing and constructing municipal improvements.
