

**RESOLUTION

*Acceptance of Bid for  
Reconstruction of J.L. Chestnut Boulevard*

(Tri-County Construction)

**WHEREAS**, the City of Selma, Alabama (*the "City"*) is the receipt of a FY 2009 CDBG-R ADECA Stimulus Grant in the amount of \$500,000.00 for road improvements; *and*

**WHEREAS**, the City published legal advertisements for three consecutive weeks in the local newspaper and at least one week in a regional newspaper to receive bids for the **J. L. Chestnut Boulevard Reconstruction Project**; *and*

**WHEREAS**, the bid documents included a base bid (Martin Luther King Street to Lauderdale Street), an additive alternate #1 (Lauderdale Street to Union Street south) and an additive alternate # 2 (Union Street south to Lapsley Street); *and*

**WHEREAS**, sealed bids were received by the City of Selma at Selma City Hall, 222 Broad Street, Selma from the time solicited and closed at 2:00pm on October 13, 2009, at which time the bids received were publicly opened and read aloud; *and*

**WHEREAS**, the appropriate officials of the City of Selma and the professional engineering firm, Goodwyn, Mills and Cawood, Inc. tabulated the bids and determined Tri-County Construction to be the lowest responsible bidder, and said bids will be certified by Goodwyn, Mills and Cawood, Inc.; *and*

**WHEREAS**, the City desires to award Tri-County Construction the Contract in the amount of \$358,540.00 for Reconstruction of **J. L. Chestnut Boulevard** pending certification of the bids by Goodwyn, Mills and Cawood, Inc.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED**, by the City Council of the City of Selma, Alabama that:

George Evans, in his capacity as Mayor, is hereby authorized to execute a contract in the amount of \$358,540.00 for Reconstruction of **J. L. Chestnut Boulevard** in accordance with the specifications provided by Goodwyn, Mills and Cawood, Inc; *and*

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED THAT** said contract expenses shall be reimbursed from the FY 2009 CDBG-R ADECA Stimulus Grant.
