FY 2009/2010 WEED AND SEED GRANT

*Authorization to submit application for Official Recognition and funding  
through the U.S. Department of Justice*

**WHEREAS**, the City of Selma desires to apply for Official recognition and a FY 2010 Weed and Seed Grant through the U.S. Department of Justice; *and*

**WHEREAS**, the City of Selma is an eligible applicant and has the legal right to apply for a Weed and Seed Grant; *and*

**WHEREAS**, the City of Selma understands the grant application will address the Weed and Seed strategy aimed to prevent, control, and reduce violent crime, criminal drug-related activity, and gang activity; *and*

**WHEREAS**, the grant application shall have a total value of \$250,000.00 per year for five years for an aggregate amount of \$1,000,000.00 with a 25% match requirement of \$62,500.00 each year incurred via the Grant Match line item; *and*


**WHEREAS**, the City of Selma recognizes that the regulations governing the Weed and Seed grant requires a 25% non-federal cash match which will be incurred via the Grant Match line item commencing with the 2010-2011 budget year.

**NOW THEREFORE , BE IT RESOLVED THAT:**

The Selma City council hereby authorizes the Office of Planning and Development to complete and submit the required information for Official Recognition by the local U.S. Attorney General and upon official recognition to submit a FY2010 Weed and Seed Grant to the U.S. Department of Justice on behalf of the City of Selma.


