FY 2010 RECREATIONAL TRAILS PROGRAM GRANT

*Authorization to submit an application to the
Alabama Department of Economic and Community Affairs*

WHEREAS, the State of Alabama has funds available to municipal governments for recreational improvements through its Community Development Block Grant; *and*

WHEREAS, the City of Selma desires to apply for a Recreational Trails Program Grant for construction of a multi-purpose trail beginning at the intersection of Satterfield Street and Riverview Avenue and ending at the intersection of Satterfield Street and Selma Avenue; *and*

WHEREAS, The total estimated project cost is \$120,000. The City desires to seek \$100,000 in Recreational Trails Program Grant funds, and agrees to provide a cash match in the amount of \$20,000; *and*

WHEREAS, In conjunction with the aforementioned project, the City proposes to convert Satterfield Street from a two-lane street into a one-lane street utilizing the Municipal gas tax revenue not to exceed \$30,000.00.

NOW THEREFORE , BE IT RESOLVED THAT:

An application to the Alabama Department of Economic and Community Affairs hereby requesting \$100,000 in grant funds is hereby approved.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the City Council hereby authorizes George Evans, in his official capacity as Mayor to sign all appropriate letters, forms and documents necessary for the submission of this grant application is also approved.


