Rehabilitation of Selma Interpretive Center

ACCEPTANCE OF BID

Frasier-Ousley Construction & Engineering, Inc.

WHEREAS, the City of Selma, Alabama (*the "City"*) published an Advertisement for Bids in the Selma Times Journal and two regional newspapers 3 to receive bids for the rehabilitation of the **Selma Interpretive Center**; *and*

WHEREAS, sealed bids were received by the City of Selma at Selma City Hall, 222 Broad Street, Selma from the time solicited and closed at 11:00 a.m. on December 10, 2009, at which time the bids received were opened and read aloud; *and*

WHEREAS the appropriate officials of the City of Selma and the professional engineering firm, Goodwyn, Mills and Cawood tabulated the bids and determined Frasier-Ousley Construction and Engineering, Inc. to be the lowest responsible bidder, said bids being certified by Goodwyn, Mills and Cawood; *and*

WHEREAS, the City desires to award Frasier-Ousley Construction and Engineering, Inc. the contract in the amount of \$775,500.00 for Rehabilitation of the Selma Interpretive Center with the specifications provided by Goodwyn, Mills and Cawood, Inc.


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the City Council of the City of Selma, Alabama that:

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED said contract expenses shall be encumbered via the NPS Statutory Aid funds received by the City of Selma from the National Park Service.




